### **Treasurer Report:**

### **Old Business:**

1. Parent Teacher Conference Meal: Angie M. reported that a Taco Bar was served to the teachers and everything went very well
2. Cookies for Kindergarten Roundup: 18 dozen were provided by volunteers; reported as a good amount, with plenty left over

4. Discussion regarding Spring Festival/Silent Auction: Needs to be a better system at checkout for Silent Auction; continued thoughts and discussion on this matter.
